Call for Papers - “Outstanding Child Researcher 2019”

About the Conference

The Sir Arthur Lewis Institute of Social and Economic Studies (SALISES), The University of the West Indies (UWI), in collaboration with The United Nations International Children’s Fund (UNICEF) is staging the annual Caribbean Child Research Conference from November 14-15, 2019.

REQUIREMENTS

Papers are invited from Caribbean children who will be under the age of 18 years at the time of the conference. The research:

- Should not be more than 3 years old.
- May comprise work undertaken for internal (school) or external examinations such as CAPE, CSEC.
- Should be undertaken by an individual student rather than a pair or a group.
- Should speak directly to the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) and at least one of the three groups of rights:
 - Protection rights (e.g. issues of violence, exploitation and abuse)
 - Provision rights (e.g. issues of health, education and social protection)
 - Participation rights (e.g. issues of involvement of children in the decision-making process, access to information, the right of children to be heard and express themselves).

SUBMISSION RULES

- The paper should be typed, double-spaced and between 7000-8000 words (excluding references), use Times New Roman 12-pt, with one-inch margins on A4 paper.
- Papers not submitted directly by the student researcher should state in the cover letter that permission to submit this paper has been received by the author.
- Plagiarism is not acceptable.
- **Papers will not be accepted if any of these rules have been violated.**
- Papers received will be acknowledged within one week.
- Papers will be judged by a sub-committee of the Caribbean Child Research Conference 2019.

PRIZES

- A scholarship of USD \$1,000.00 will be awarded to the overall top child researcher
- Prizes will be awarded to the top ten finalists. Separate entry required. See our website for further details
- Other prizes will be given for outstanding presentations
